<h2>How are NetPoint Administrators and Master Identity Administrators represented in the COREid configuration data?</h2>	
<p>NetPoint Administrators and Master Identity Administrators are members of two group objects of type <i>oblixGroupOfUniqueNames</i> stored in the LDAP directory directly under the COREid Configuration DN.</p> <p>If you need to find out what the configuration DN is for your COREid installation, find the <code>setup.xml</code> file in your identity server install directory config folder and locate the following XML element:</p> <pre data-bbox="300 969 979 1084"> <NameValPair ParamName="configDN" Value="YOUR CONFIGURATION DN IS HERE"> </NameValPair> </pre> <p>The members of a <i>oblixGroupOfUniqueNames</i> object are listed in its multi-valued <i>obUniqueMemberStr</i> attribute.</p> <p>NetPoint Administrators are members of the Web Masters group, whose DN is:</p> <p>CN=Web Masters,OU=Oblix,<config DN></p> <p>Master Identity Administrators are members of the Directory Administrators group, whose DN is:</p> <p>CN=Directory Administrators,OU=Oblix, <config DN></p>
